The School of Professional Psychology at Wright State University (SOPP) is home to an APA accredited PsyD program as well as an APA accredited doctoral internship. The faculty of SOPP are dedicated to teaching the diverse student body at the innovative main campus of Wright State University and at the Duke E. Ellis Human Development Institute, both located in Dayton, Ohio.

SOPP was among the first doctoral programs in the country to develop a practitioner model program and to grant the Doctor of Psychology (PsyD) degree. SOPP accepted its first students in 1978. The PsyD and internship programs have continuously received the highest level of APA accreditation since the graduation of the charter class in 1982. The brilliance, expertise, and richness of our School continues to allow the SOPP faculty, staff and students to lead by example in the community, the state of Ohio, and nationally. Today, we have more than 800 graduates practicing worldwide.

Within a context of respect for individual and cultural differences, our curriculum integrates the evolving knowledge base, expansion of clinical skills, and development of professional attitudes, values, and behaviors. Using this foundation, SOPP readies its graduates for excellence and innovation in the practice of health service psychology. Our program emphasizes generalist training; however, students may pursue in depth work in three emphasis areas: Child and family, forensic, and health/rehabilitation/neuropsychology.
